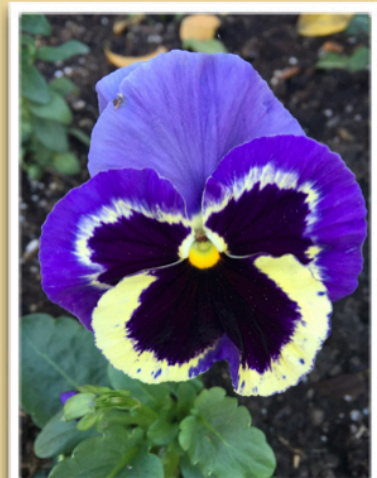

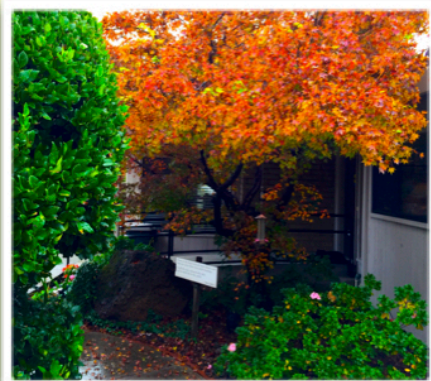
A Moment of Recognition
